NATURAL AREAS AT

The High Plains Environmental Center (HPEC) is a nonprofit organization that manages the natural areas around Barefoot Lakes. Our goal to restore native Colorado habitat that supports wildlife, especially pollinators.

The natural areas at Barefoot Lakes already have the capacity to support many different types of wildlife throughout the year, and the HPEC is working to restore more of the native plant community and improve habitat quality in these natural areas to benefit even more wildlife. We are implementing a long-term management plan to remove invasive weeds and restore native grasses so that both human and wildlife visitors can enjoy the natural areas at Barefoot Lakes.

Habitat: Marshes, Mangroves, Wet Meadows, Lake Edge/ Shoreline

Size: 2.5-3 ft Tall, 6.6 – 14 lbs, 6ft – 7ft Wingspan

Diet: Fish, Small Mammals (Squirrels, Prairie Dogs, Rabbits,

Racoons), & Birds (Waterfowl)

Habitat: Seacoasts, Rivers, Lakes, Marshes: Open Waters w/ Fish

Size: 9-10 in Tall, Approx. 0.2 lbs, 14-15 in Wingspan Diet: Insects, Spiders, Invertebrates, & Seeds & Grains

Habitat: Cattail Marsh, Wooded Or Brushy Swamps, Wet Meadows, Hay Fields, Salt Marshes, Canals & Ditches- Wetlands w/ Vegetation

SHOREBIRD

Size: 9-11 in. tall, 0.15 – 0.2 lbs, 9 – 11 in wingspan

Diet: Insects (Beetles, Caterpillars, Grasshoppers, Fly Larvae) & Other

Bugs (Spiders, Worms, Snails)

Habitat: Prairies w/ Water, Coastal Wetlands, Beaches, Coastal Fields
